

Apliquick Turned-Edge Appliqué

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Supply List

Discover the Apliquick method for turned-edge appliqué. In this class, we will practice turning under the seam allowance and discuss the options for sewing the block by hand or machine. Sewing will not be done in half-day class.

Apliquick rods: available in class so you can try before you buy, or bring your own set.

Fabric Requirements

- 3 fat quarters for background, vines and leaves, flowers
- 1 fat eighth for flower centers
- 0.5 m Apliquick interfacing

Other Supplies

- glue stick - available for purchase
- pencil
- scissors for detailed cutting
- tweezers (optional but recommended - some will be available in class)
- light box for tracing (optional)

- working surface for gluing such as:
 - Teflon non-stick appliqué sheet
 - Scrap paper

We will work on a sample block in class but feel free to bring your own appliqué project for tips and suggestions.

Full-Day Class

In addition to the items above, bring the appropriate supplies for hand or machine appliqué.

Hand Appliqué

- appliqué needle
- fine cotton or silk thread to match appliqué fabrics

Machine Appliqué

- sewing machine with appliqué presser foot
- fine cotton or silk thread to match appliqué fabrics or invisible thread
