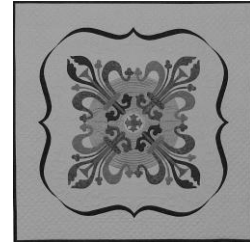

Using needle-turn or Appliquick turned-edge appliqué, we will begin the trumpet block from the award-winning quilt *Instruments of Praise*.

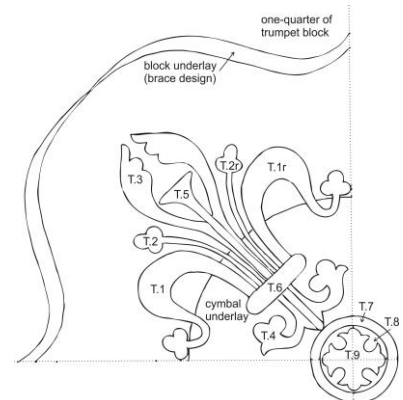


### Fabric Requirements

- Background fabric: 24" x 24"
- Appliqué fabric (see my website for photos and color ideas):

Cymbal underlay (gold silk in sample)	12" x 12"	1	fat quarter
T.1	4 1/2" x 4 1/2"	8	0.2 m
T.2	5" x 1 3/4"	8	0.2 m
T.3	3 1/2" x 7"	4	0.1 m
T.4	4 1/2" x 2 1/2"	4	0.1 m
T.5 (trumpet)	2 1/2" x 7 1/4"	4	0.1 m
T.6	3 1/4" x 1 1/4"	4	0.1 m
T.7	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	1	
T.8	3" x 3"	1	
T.9	2 3/4" x 2 3/4"	1	
Brace design & binding	24" x 24"	1	0.7 m

\* Dimensions are guidelines only. Patches do not need to be precut.



### For Needle-turn Appliqué:

- freezer paper and pencil *or* purchased freezer-paper templates

### For Appliquick Method:

- Appliquick interfacing, glue stick and rods

### Other Supplies

- fine cotton (50-weight or 60-weight) or silk threads to match appliqué fabrics
- appliqué needle
- appliqué pins
- removable fabric marking pens or pencils – visible on all fabrics

*NOTE: If you cannot see through your background fabric or cymbal underlay fabric for tracing, also bring graphite paper, Transdoodle paper, or some other type of transfer paper to mark the fabric from the top.*

- scissors for detailed cutting
- paper scissors, if desired
- sandpaper board (optional)
- light box (if you have one)
- Ziploc bag to hold freezer paper templates
